


Clipping a Horse's Bridle Path

Clipping

Before using the clippers make sure your horse is used to the noise they make.

Let horse smell them while they are off.

Then turn them on and see how the horse reacts. If all is fine you are ready to proceed. If not more clipper training is advised.



Bridle Path

The bridle path needs to be trimmed regularly so the bridle and halter sit nicely in the correct position. It is a small section roughly 2 fingers wide.



Slide the halter back down the horse's mane so it is off of the area to be trimmed.

Use clippers going front to back to remove mane in that small section.

It only needs to be as wide as the halter.
